What equipment is required?

You will need a mask, snorkel, fins and wet suit boots. All other equipment is supplied for your training sessions. We suggest you consult with us before you purchase these items so you are aware of the correct fit, form and function in order to make an educated purchase.

- **1.** Classroom lectures introduce you to the topics of diving physics, physiology, medicine, environment, and dive safety.

All Scuba Certifications start with 2 to 3 days of classroom and confined water training (pool). Half the day consists of classroom and the other half consists of pool work. The day runs from 8:00 am till 5:00 pm. The classroom portion can also be taken over the internet at your own convenience. After this you will be ready for your Open Water Training Dives. This is where the differences due to time of the year come into factor.

Local Scuba Certification

Local Scuba Certification is 2 weekends in length, (the first weekend Saturday & Sunday). The second weekend (Saturday & Sunday) runs from 8:00 am until 4:00 PM at Haigh Quarry for your training dives. Once you have completed your skills and final exam you are certified. Welcome to the underwater world of scuba.

Scuba Certification on Vacation

Scuba Certification on your Vacation consists of classroom and pool sessions here locally over 3 weekend days. Then on any of our Trip to Exotic Locations you complete the Open Water Training Dives.
