Advanced SCUBA Classes Every Weekend

What: The advanced scuba course consists of 6 dives with pre and post dive briefings, and a textbook. Each emphasizing a particular skill and performed in water. These are fun dives and a fun way to achieve better skills.

Who: This class is open to any certified basic or junior scuba diver. The class is designed to advance diving skills or can be used as a refresher.

When: The class can be completed in as little as two days or fit to your schedule.

Where: Our favorite places to hold this class include: Haigh Quarry, wreck diving on Lake Michigan, on our Florida trip, or any other IID trip.

Includes: Instruction, 6 dives, text, exam, certification card, use of salvage bag & compass.

Not included: Scuba equipment, underwater lights, tanks, air fills, admissions, boat fees, transportation and meals.

Class size: 2 to 6 students per instructor.

Cost: \$199.00

Some more Details about the Class.

This course is a continuing education certification course for certified divers. It is an enjoyable program of continued supervised experience designed to introduce divers to a variety of diving activities and to be taught entirely in an open water setting. Upon successful completion of this course, graduates are considered competent to engage in open water diving activities without supervision, provided the diving activities and the areas dived approximate those of training.

Open Water Training Dives.

A minimum of six open water dives is required. A maximum of three dives per day shall be applied toward course requirements. The required dive topic areas listed represents three separate dives of the minimum six required. The remaining dives can be combined or split as needed to fit the situation and meet student needs provided at least six separate dives are made.

Navigation

Night or low visibility diving

Deep diving (130 feet/40 meters maximum depth)

Elective Dives.

Search and recovery

Boat diving

Light salvage

Hunting and collecting

Exploration and underwater mapping

Non-penetration wreck diving

Observation and data collection

Diving in surf or currents

Altitude diving

Salt water diving (in areas where most diving is in fresh water)

Fresh water diving (in areas where most diving is in salt water)

Shore diving

Diving for photos or video
